NOTIFICATION

The following guidelines for open competitive examination to be conducted by the Sikkim Public Service Commission in 2024 for selection of candidates for appointment in the post of Block Officer in Level – 11 of the Pay matrix under Forest & Environment Department is notified and published for general information.

- 01. The number of vacancies to be filled up after the Examination will be specified in the Notice to be issued by the Sikkim Public Service Commission.
- 02. The examination will be conducted by the Sikkim Public Service Commission according to the syllabus and procedure as indicated in Appendix I to this rule.
- 03. The date and the place of the Examination will be fixed by the Sikkim Public Service Commission.
- 04. A candidate must pay requisite fees as may be prescribed by the Commission.
- 05. The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility of a candidate for admission to the examination shall be final. Their admission to the examination for which they are admitted by the Commission Viz. written examination will be purely PROVISIONAL, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification at any time before or after the written examination, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions; their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the Commission.
- 06. No candidates will be admitted to the examination unless he/she holds certificate of admission issued by the Commission. Their admission to all stages of the Examination will be purely PROVISIONAL subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility test. Mere issue of admission certificate to the candidate will not imply that his/her candidature has been finally cleared by the Commission.
- 07. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty of any attempt on his./her part to obtain support for his/her candidature by any means shall render him/her liable to be disqualified for admission to the competitive examination.
- 08. (a) Mobile phones, pagers, smart watches, blue tooth, head phones but except for hearing aid for hard of hearing, or any other communication devices are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Infringement of these instructions shall entail appropriate action including ban from taking the examination.
 - (b) Candidates are advised not to bring any valuable/costly items to the examination hall, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. Commission will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
- (c) Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including mobile phones/pagers to the venue of the examination as arrangement for safe keeping cannot be assured.
- 09. The Commission shall have the discretion to fix the qualifying marks in any or all subjects in the written examination.
- 10. The form and manner of announcement of results of the examinations shall be decided by the Commission. The Commission will not enter into any correspondence with any candidate regarding results.

- 11. After the examination, the names of the successful candidates will be arranged by the Commission in order of merit based on marks awarded to each candidate. Candidate shall be considered for appointment to the available vacancy in the order in which their name shall appear in the merit list.
- 12. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission guilty of impersonation or of submitting false and fabricated documents which have been tampered with; or of making statement which are incorrect or false or of suppressing material information; or resorting to use unfair means in the examination hall or otherwise; or resorting to any or other irregular or improper means for obtaining admission to the examination hall may, in addition to rendering himself/ herself liable to criminal procedure be debarred:
 - (a) By the Commission permanently or for a specified period for admission to any examination or appearance at any of the interviews held by the Commission for selection of candidates;
 - (b) By the State Government from any employment under them.
- 13. Candidatesalready in Government service or in government owned undertaking or similar organization, whether in permanent or temporary capacity or as work charged employee shall be required to submit their application along with No Objection Certificate from their Organization /Department.
- 14. Success in the examination confers no right to appointment unless the Government is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate having regard to his/ her character and antecedents is suitable in all respects for appointment.
- 15. Candidate must be physically fit to discharge their duties as an employee of the Service. Candidate who (after such medical examination as may be prescribed by the competent authority) is found not to satisfy these requirements will not be appointed.
- 16. No Travel and Daily Allowance will be paid for the journey performed in connection with the examination, interview and medical examination. All other matters not specified for which no provision has been made in these rules shall be regulated by the rules and orders applicable to the service to which recruitments are being made.
- 17. The candidate on selection and during the period of probation/ apprenticeship/ training, pay shall be government by the Notification No. 489/GEN/DOP dated: 31.10.2011.
- 18. Scheme/ pattern of the examination will determined by the Sikkim Public Service Commission.
