NOTIFICATION

The Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Sikkim hereby prescribed the following rules to conduct open competitive examination through the Sikkim Public Service Commission (in short 'SPSC' or 'Commission') for appointment of members under Academic Wing (Faculty and Library) of the Sikkim Government Pharmacy College Service, as under, namely:

- 1. The Examination will be conducted by the Commission according to the conditions of eligibility for appearing in the examination as prescribed in **Appendix I** appended to these rules.
- 2. The scheme and pattern of examination for appearing in the competitive examination is as prescribed in **Appendix III** appended to these rules and the composition of the Selection Committee shall be as per **Appendix IV** appended to these rules.
- 3. The mode of examination shall be conducted in accordance to the UGC Regulations/ AICTE Regulations for appointment of teachers in colleges.
- 4. The date and place of examination will be fixed by the Commission.
- 5. A candidate must pay fees as may be prescribed by the Commission.
- 6. The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility of a candidate for admission to the examination shall be final. Their admission at all stages of examination for which they are admitted by the Commission viz., written examination or oral test or both, as may be applicable, will be purely **provisional**, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification at any time before or after the written examination or oral test or both, as the case may be, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the Commission.
- 7. No candidate will be admitted to the examination unless they hold a certificate of admission issued by the Commission. Their admission to all the stages of the examination will be purely **provisional** subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility test. Mere issue of admission certificate to the candidate will not imply that their candidature has been finally cleared by the Commission.
- 8. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty or any attempt on their part to obtain support for their candidature by any means shall render them liable to be disqualified for admission to the competitive examination.
- 9. (a) Mobile phones, Pagers or any other communication devices are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Infringement of these instructions shall entail appropriate action including ban from taking the examination.
 - (b). Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including mobiles/phones/ pagers to the venue of the examination, as arrangement for safe keeping cannot be assured.
 - (c) Candidates are advised not to bring any valuable/ costly items to the examination halls as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. Commission will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
- 10. A candidate, who obtains the minimum qualifying marks in the written examination if held so, shall have to appear for Viva-voce/ interview.
- 11. The form and manner of announcement of results of the examinations shall be decided by the Commission. The Commission will not enter into any correspondence with any candidate regarding results.
- 12. After the examination and interview, the names of the successful candidates will be arranged by the Commission in the order of merit based on marks awarded to each candidate. Candidates shall be considered for appointment to the available vacancies in the order in which their names appear in the merit list.

- 13. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission guilty of impersonation or of submitting false and fabricated documents which have been tampered with or of making statements which are incorrect or false or of suppressing material information or of attempting to any or other irregular or improper means for obtaining admission to the examination hall may, in addition to rendering themselves liable to criminal prosecution, be debarred:
 - (a) by the Commission permanently or for specified period for admission to any examination or appearance at any of the interviews held by the Commission for selection of candidates,
 - (b) by the State Government from any employment under them.
- 14. Candidates, already in the Government service or in the Government owned undertaking or similar organization, whether in permanent or temporary capacity shall be, required to submit their application alongwith **No objection Certificate** of their employer.
- 15. Success in the examination confers no right to appointment unless the Government is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that a candidate having regard to their character and antecedents is suitable in all respect for appointment.
- 16. A candidate must be in good health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of their duties as an official of the Service. A candidate who (after such medical examination as may be prescribed by the competent authority, is found not to satisfy these requirements will not be appointed.
- 17. No travelling and daily allowance will be paid for the journey performed in connection with the examination, interview and medical examination. All other matters not specified or for which no provision has been made in these rules shall be regulated by the rules and orders applicable to the Service to which recruitments are being made.
- 18. Scheme/ pattern of examination will be as determined by the SPSC in accordance to the UGC guidelines/ AICTE guidelines.
- 19. The candidate on selection and during the period of probation/ apprenticeship/ training, pay shall be governed by the Notification number 489/ GEN/ DOP; Dated: 31st October, 2011.
- 20. The Commission/ Department (s) will not entertain any application on review or RTI/ Correspondence till the entire process of recruitment is complete.
- 21. Any further instruction/ corrigendum/ addendum shall be published for information to all.
